Title V Permit Holder:

Title V permits are valid for 5 years, after which the facility must apply for renewal. Application for renewal must be received at least 6 months, but no more than 18 months before the date of permit expiration. Permit expiration terminates a source's right to operate unless a timely and complete renewal application has been submitted, in which case the existing permit shall remain in effect until the Department takes final action on the renewal application.

Renewal permits are subject to the same application and procedural requirements that apply to initial permit issuance. Forms and instructions are available from the Department or on our web site at [www.adeq.state.ar.us](http://www.adeq.state.ar.us).

Please note that for renewals, you will need to consider and include in your application the following:

1. New regulations. Many new regulations, especially MACT, have been promulgated in the last several years. If any of these new requirements affect your facility, the requirements should be incorporated into your Title V application.
2. Compliance Assurance Monitoring (CAM) rule. This rule, was promulgated in October of 1997 and affects many sources with air pollution control equipment. Rules and additional information can be obtained on the EPA website [www.epa.gov/oar/oaqps/permits/index.html](http://www.epa.gov/oar/oaqps/permits/index.html). Emission units affected by this regulation must submit a plan meeting the requirements of this rule.
3. Operational Flexibility. Title V regulations allow for operational flexibility, however, these alternate scenarios must be identified in the Title V permit. You may want to consider ways to incorporate flexibility into your permit.

Again, you are reminded that permit expiration terminates a source's right to operate unless a timely and complete renewal application has been submitted.
