On 27 September 2010, I investigated the complaint. The storm drain located at this area had water running into it, but it did not appear to be sewage, (by appearance and smell). He also stated that back in the Winter the line had been filled with dirt due to the construction project for the AHTD. He said plans were to raise the grade of the manhole.
