A site visit was conducted at Tyson Foods-Industrial Park Facility during the recent Pretreatment Compliance Inspection of the City of Pine Bluff-Boyd Point Wastewater Facility. The Tyson Foods-Industrial Park facility is a poultry slaughtering and further processing plant. Wastewater from the kill unit and further processing unit is screened and pumped into a 555,000 gallon E.Q. Tank, pH is controlled with H2SO4 then pumped to the DAF Units where polymers are added to cause solids to flock and float out of the DAF Units to the effluent pit. The pit is where the city takes there routine samples.
