This IU visit revealed that facility representatives were not familiar with the pretreatment requirements. According to on-site representatives, this IU may be discharging boiler blowdown into the PLWC collection system. NOTE: The facility did not renew ARG250011 permit coverage for boiler blowdown which expired on November 30, 2012. During the IU visit, on site representatives were not aware of any additional treatment units or an NPDES permitted outfall for boiler blowdown. Site reps stated that all wastewater now goes to PLWC. A notice of intent was received by the Department on March 28, 2013 and the facility obtained NPDES permit (ARG250011) coverage on April 24, 2013 to discharge boiler blowdown to waters of the State. A follow up inspection will be conducted at a later date.
