Dear Ms. Trotta:

Alma has received the proposed Consent Administrative Order(CAO) of October 16, 2017 and would like to respectfully request the following modifications and clarifications to the CAO.

1. We would like to request amending the corrective action plan (CAP) to allow an extension. During the next year, Alma will continue working toward getting the wastewater treatment system into compliance. Particularly, algae seems to be causing the effluent excursions. Currently, the CAP runs through July 30, 2018. Alma requests modifying the CAP, allowing the treatment plant to operate through another "algae season" so the effectiveness of the corrective actions may be observed. We respectfully request changing the date to be in compliance to December 31, 2018.
2. During the time the corrective action plan is implemented, Alma will operate the wastewater treatment system to comply with the permitted effluent limits to the maximum extent practicable. Alma requests ADEQ to understand that some exceedances may be possible while implementing corrections to bring the algae growth into control.
3. Alma requests the \$2400 fine be reduced to \$1000. This will allow Alma to put the money toward pursuing corrective action to bring the wastewater treatment system into compliance.

Alma is making progress on corrective action as outlined in the July 14, 2017 CAP. Thus far, Alma has spent \$4189.45 on repairs to aeration equipment in lagoon #1. Another \$16,075.80 is required for additional aerator repairs.

The cost to address the algae causing the BOD and TSS exceedances will be a minimum of \$55,200.


Documentation is included with this response letter.

The repairs are a burden on Alma's finances, however Alma is committed to making the required corrections and respectfully requests relief in the form of reducing the fine.

4. Alma will provide quarterly progress reports while taking corrective action to bring the wastewater treatment system into compliance.

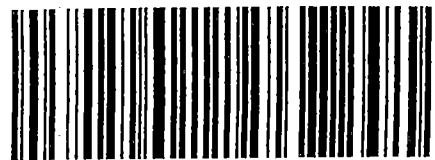

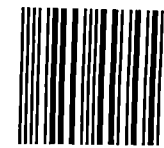
