Dear Ms. Williams:

The City continues to make progress in completing the wet weather improvements identified by its Wastewater Management Plan during this reporting period. During this fourth quarter reporting period the City has continued work on the Zero Street pump station and equalization facility project, the Mill Creek pump station and equalization facility and the Mill Creek capacity sewer project. The City also completed the 2014 collection system flow monitoring and the Division Street sewer line repair project. The two replacement pumps for the Massard pump station, station number 3, purchased during the third quarter period have been shipped by the manufacturer and are in route to Fort Smith.

The city's sewer line maintenance and construction programs made numerous system repairs during this reporting period. Their work accomplished 6 point and main line repairs which replaced 60 feet of line, jet cleaned 33,713 feet of line, CCTV inspected 218,956 feet of line, and replaced 34 defective service lines.

Especially significant during this quarter's reporting period is that the City and Department of Justice have reached an agreement on a Consent Decree for the further wastewater system improvements to be made by the City. The Department of Justice has filed the Complaint on this date and will lodge the Consent Decree on January 2, 2015. That action will conclude the above captioned Administrative Order and this will be the final reporting to be made as part of that Order. Future reporting will be provided as set out by the Consent Decree's reporting requirements.

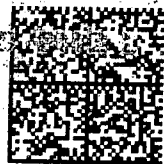
