City of Fort Smith Request Pursuant to Paragraph 41.b.vii. of the Consent Decree

Dear Mr. Walters:

Our office has received the City of Fort Smith's request dated October 25, 2017 to use the SL-RAT in its Small-Diameter Gravity Sewer Line Cleaning Program for the purpose of prioritizing the cleaning schedule required by Paragraph 41.b. of the Consent Decree (CD) in the above-captioned case. In addition to prioritizing cleaning, the City stated in its request that the SL-RAT may be used to assist the City in prioritizing rehab and repair work, assessing the extent of blockages by roots, FOG (Fat, Oil, and Grease), damages in pipes, and other types of common blockages, as well as prioritizing types of condition assessment typically encountered while implementing the CMOM program.

EPA approves the City's request to use the SL-RAT to prioritize the injunctive relief tasks in the CD as outlined above. Notwithstanding EPA's approval of the use of the SL-RAT, the City shall remain responsible for compliance with the terms of the CD and the Clean Water Act. EPA's approval does not waive or modify the requirements of the CD. The City's use of the SL-RAT shall not constitute a substitution for the investigation techniques and requirements found under Paragraph 14 of the CD or the cleaning requirements under Paragraph 41 of the CD. Finally, please submit to EPA any standard operating procedures (SOP) developed for the use of the SL-RAT.
