CMOM - Standard Operating Procedures Program Plan for EPA Review and Approval

Dear Mr. Geffken:

This office has received the City of Fort Smith's (City) Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) component of the Capacity, Management, Operation, and Maintenance (CMOM) Program, pursuant to Paragraph 53 of the Consent Decree in the above-captioned case. EPA has reviewed this submittal dated June 28, 2016, and has concerns regarding the proposed SOPs development schedules.

As documented in the City's SOP Program Plan (illustrated on Page 3-2 in Table 3-1), these schedules range from two years (24 months) to six years (72 months). EPA currently expects that standard practice final SOPs take no more than one year (12 months) to develop and implement in order to achieve the goals and objectives of this Consent Decree.

However, EPA has decided to approve this submittal and allow the City to continue with its proposed SOP timetables, provided that the City's proposed SOP timetables for development or finalization do not disturb the Consent Decree goals or objectives. This includes a standardized set of instructions to be utilized by the Utility Department so as to promote the safe, effective, and successful work processes related to the operation and maintenance of the wastewater collection and transmission system.
