Due to unforeseeable circumstances, the City of Fort Smith would like the following Sanitary Sewer Overflow (SSO) to be declared as Force Majeure under Article XII of the Consent Decree, against which it would have been unreasonable to take precautions and could not have been avoided.

Even by using it's best efforts this was beyond the control of the City of Fort Smith. A contractor working on the Highway 255 widening project failed to properly seal the abandoned upstream sewer main, therefore allowing heavy infiltration. The failed seal accompanied with a plugged downstream line caused the overflow of what is now an abandoned part of the system. Any water spilled was strictly rain water, as there is no active sewer connection.
