DISCUSSION:

IOutbound call/Discussed the DMR reported effluent limit violations from August 1, 2016 through July 31, 2021, at the facility and reasons for the occurrences/Mr. Boston stated in January they had a large lightning strike that knocked out about \$30,000 worth of equipment, and weakened a number of other systems that have been slowly failing/In February nitrifiers died, and in May, the two main blowers went out. He stated they had a single spare but sharing the single blower was not sufficient to avoid the Nitrogen violations while they worked to get replacement blowers./New blowers are now in place, and they were back to compliance in July and expect to finish August in compliance./Plant expansion to 3.8 MGD was completed in Feb 2019/Almost immediately due to rapid expansion in region, both public and industrial, they were running back at or near capacity/This also has impacted process/They have begun the next design process to further expand the facility and are preparing to release bids for the design team in next 30 days./Also discussed impact of I&I issues briefly./Advised Mr. Boston a request for CAP would likely be forthcoming due to the violations.
