Dear Ms. Bolenbaugh,

The Decatur WWTP in March 2019 exceeded the following permit limit, three days of high Nitrates 13.1 mg/l being the highest day. Also our new Phosphorus limit we were 0.56 on the thirty day average and 1.11 on the seven day average. We are close on these just trying to dial these last two parameters.

Our Wastewater treatment plant is at substantial completion, we are doing will on meeting our limits, with Nitrates and Phosphorus being the last parameter that is a challenge for us, but we expect to reach compliance on all parameter's soon.

Our contractor is still on site at our Wastewater treatment plant. Until we are completed we will continue to do our very best to meet all of our permit limits.
