The City of El Dorado – North Plant currently maintains coverage under NPDES Permit No. AR0033936 for which the first modification was effective November 1, 2015. In accordance with schedule set forth in Part 1B of the permit, this correspondence serves as the third and final progress report toward achieving compliance with Total Recoverable Lead permit limitations at Outfall 001.

In accordance with the above referenced permit, North Plant utilizes Outfall 010N, which discharges to the Ouachita River Joint Pipeline, as its primary outfall. Outfall 001 would only be used during emergent situations. Outfall 001 has not discharged since the North Plant commenced discharging to the Ouachita River Joint Pipeline in October 2013.

The City of El Dorado – South Plant has achieved final compliance at Outfall 001 by maintaining its current operational practices by continuing to discharge through Outfall 010N and not through Outfall 001.




