We feel this problem was due to:

The Davidson Wastewater Treatment Plant is operating under a construction permit; with the installation of cloth media filters and associated piping. We diverted all flow to the Equalization Pond for a few days. Once flow returned, the Total Suspended Solids and Ammonia's spiked beyond our permit parameters.


We plan to correct the problem in this manner:

The Plant is back in full operation mode, the pond is empty and we are meeting our permit parameters.

We anticipate completion of the cloth filters very soon. There have been delays for lack of vendors receiving pipes and other supplies. We hope to have filters online in October.
