The following is a brief synopsis of progress regarding the CAO.

The City of Hot Springs staff has met with Crist Engineers on a monthly basis, beginning in October 2021, to develop improvements to the Davidson Drive Wastewater Treatment Plant. The plans, now at 90% complete status, will be sent to DEQ within the next two weeks for approval. Bid Date for the project will be based on the DEQ Construction Permit being issued.

The estimated \$17.6 million in improvements include:

- Chemical Feed
- Secondary Clarifier
- Yard Piping
- Aeration System
- UV Disinfection
- Outfall Piping to Discharge Point

Construction completion is estimated for September 2024.
