### SIGNIFICANT CHANGES FROM THE PREVIOUSLY ISSUED PERMIT

The permittee is responsible for carefully reading the permit in detail and becoming familiar with all of the changes therein:

1. The sludge disposal condition, Part II.8 of the previous permit, was removed from the permit. Sludge disposal is addressed in Part III.B.6 of the permit.
2. Part III.C.5 of the permit now requires that DMRs be submitted electronically via NetDMR.
3. A sub-lethal limit for *C. dubia* has been included in the permit. See Item No. 13 of this Fact Sheet for additional information.
4. The requirements to test the CBOD5 and the TSS limits in the influent have been removed.
5. A monitoring frequency condition has been added to Part II of the permit.
6. The April FCB limits have been corrected. See Item Nos. 12.A and 12.B of this Fact Sheet for additional information.
7. The decimal places for the CBOD5 concentration limits have been removed in accordance with the OWQ's updated rounding procedures.
8. The WWTP is being modified. As a result, the following changes have been made to the permit:
  - a. Loading limits have increased due to a higher design flow.
  - b. PAA limits are replacing TRC limits due to a change in the type of disinfection.
  - c. Two tiers of limits have been included – one for the current WWTP and one for the modified WWTP. A transition condition has been included in Part II of the permit.
  - d. A requirement to conduct a full PPS within 45 days of beginning operation of the new WWTP has been added to Part IB of the permit.
