Danielle – Thank you for touching base. As you may be aware Walnut Ridge is planning to utilize PAA as the disinfectant for FCB compliance. As such, field testing was required by the Water Division for supplemental information for the construction and modification permit request. As such, a workplan was developed and approved by ADEQ.

We received the field test results and evaluation on August 9. At the time of writing Progress Report 05, we considered the results conclusive, and not in favor for PAA use. However, upon further evaluation it was determined the results were not conclusive due to the workplan not being followed.

A subsequent WET test was scheduled and conducted. We received the results of the field tests yesterday, October 3. The field tests concluded favorable for PAA use as a disinfectant. As such, we will now move forward and submit our construction plans, specification, and modification request. We will assemble this information and submit on or before October 18.

At this time, we do not expect to request an extension on the overall completion date of the order.

This effort will be formally documented at the next progress report.
