Your coverage under the Landfill Sediment Pond Discharge General Permit (ARG160000) with tracking numbers ARG160019 (Class I landfill ponds) and ARG160033 (Class IV landfill ponds) expired on February 29, 2020. If these facilities are still in operation, you are operating without a permit, which is a violation of the Arkansas Water and Air Pollution Control Act (Ark. Code Ann. § 8-4-101 *et seq.*), and the Clean Water Act (33 U.S.C. § 1251 *et seq.*).

If you wish to renew coverage under this general permit, please complete and return the two (2) Recertification Notice of Intent (NOIs) included with this correspondence.
