Subject: ARG160047 Renewal of Permit Coverage

A Recertification NOI for ARG160047, Clark County Class 4 Landfill was submitted to the Department on 2/2/2015. It was discovered during a routine enforcement check that this facility has had 9 TSS violations in the past three years. The Enforcement Branch sent a letter to the facility on 2/4/2015 requiring the development and submittal of a Corrective Action Plan addressing the 9 effluent violations no later than 3/4/2015. The TSS limit in the ARG160000 permit is 100 mg/l. According to the Non Compliance Reports available on the ADEQ website, the facility had results for TSS ranging from 110-150 mg/l. Copies of the Non Compliance Reports can be found at the following link:

Parts 1.7.1.1. and 1.7.1.2. of the ARG160000 state that the Director may require an individual NPDES permit for reasons including that the discharger is a significant contributor of pollution or that the discharger is not in compliance with the conditions of the general permit. It is my determination that coverage under this general permit (with permit tracking number ARG160047) should be renewed, provided that the requirements from the Enforcement Branch are met. The Corrective Action Plan required by the Enforcement Branch is due after the expiration date of the current permit, which does not allow time for the permit coverage to be renewed prior to expiration. If the required documentation is not submitted to the Department, or if the facility continues to have effluent violations, the Department may require the facility to obtain an individual NPDES discharge permit. The renewal letter to the facility will also include this information.
