Please note that the October 14, 2011 effluent concentration (110 μ g/l) exceeded the permit limit (85.5 μ g/l) for Zinc.

The City must show how many NOVs were issued to each SIU. This concern was also noted in the last Department's letter/email (dated March 3, 2011). <u>Please</u> make a note as a reminder for the 2012 annual report.
