Dear Mr. Gilliam:

As per our discussion of this date, a careful review of Springdale's approved Pretreatment Program yielded the following minor modifications.

- 1. The organizational chart has been modified, necessitating small changes to the IPP administration. Specifically, several titles have changed, and the Industrial Monitor position has been replaced by an additional Laboratory Technician position. These changes have not decreased the number of staff hours allocated to the Industrial Pretreatment Program.
- 2. Pretreatment software is no longer used to track IU compliance. The level of compliance is so great that it is much easier to calculate compliance by hand instead of using tracking software. The Data Management section of the IPP reflects this change.
- 3. Minor changes in wording of the SOP Inspection and Sampling section better reflect the actual process being used to implement these procedures. It is felt that these small changes make for a more effective field program, and allow the flexibility needed to foster a positive rapport between Utility staff and IU staff.
