Cave City File:

Attached is the authorization letter from Cave City's Honorable Mayor Ronald Burge allowing UniFirst's wastewater to be discharged from its printing operations on business/industry rugs/mats and the like.

Cave City adopted a partial (no legal authority to enforce provisions) Pretreatment Ordinance on 5/27/14 with specific "local limits" (basis unknown). This "Ordinance" has been scanned to ADEQ's G-drive (internet accessible). This office had no time to review and submit comments/recommendations.

The City was notified on 10/1/14 of their NPDES permit requirement to provide adequate notice to the ADEQ Water Division Branch of: "1. Any new introduction of pollutants into the treatment works from an indirect discharger which would be subject to Sections 301 or 306 of the Act if it were directly discharging those pollutants; and 2. Any substantial change in the volume or character of pollutants being introduced into the treatment works by a source introducing pollutants into the treatment works at the time of issuance of the permit.

Any notice shall include information on (i) the quality and quantity of effluent to be introduced into the treatment works, and (ii) any anticipated impact of the change on the quality or quantity of effluent to be discharged from the POTW."


