Steve's letter indicated that the City officials "need to establish current water quality characteristics at our plant and within the collection system..". The City should already have sufficient influent and effluent samples since the NPDES permit requires quarterly sampling for influent and effluent.

Since the City wants to void the local limits shown in the pretreatment ordinance no. 4577 (Section 9-3-43.4) and the City wishes to have some form of control over the local industries, I recommend that the City consider performance-based local limits. These limits reflect the industries historical discharge to the POTW and provide "control".

Finally, the City does not need domestic sampling results to develop MAHLs. The City already has sufficient information to develop MAHLs. The City does not have to "replace" the numbers in the existing ordinance. The City may completely omit numbers in the next ordinance and only reference a TBLL document with MAHLs/MAILs (Maximum Allowable Headworks Loadings/Maximum Allowable Industrial Loadings).

I can furnish the City with recommended MAHLs but I need the current sludge rate.

In conclusion, the local limit process is an ongoing process and not just an isolated occurrence. Since the City has sufficient sampling information to submit the MAHLs to ADEQ now, I see no reason to grant an extension.

The MAHLs must be submitted by March 1, 2009.
