ARKANSAS DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY'S STATEMENT OF BASIS AND PURPOSE

- 1. The Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) requests that the Arkansas Pollution Control and Ecology Commission promulgate permanent Regulation No. 36: Tire Accountability Program pursuant to Act 317 of the 2017 Regular Session of the Arkansas General Assembly and the Used Tire Recycling and Accountability Act, Ark. Code Ann. § 8-9-401 et seq.
- 2. The new regulation provides comprehensive program administration information for the new Tire Accountability Program and includes general provisions; definitions; guidelines and requirements for the administration of used tire programs, including used tire program accountability and business plans, performance and efficiency evaluations, the e-manifest system, and disbursements from the Used Tire Recycling Fund; procedures for tire generators; procedures for the collection and remittance of rim removal fees, commercial generator fees, and import fees; procedures for beneficial use projects; prohibited activities concerning waste tire sites; requirements for landfilling waste tires; and requirements for tire collection centers and tire processing facilities.
- 3. Regulation 36 is necessary to serve the public interest and ensure compliance with state law.
