Dear Mr. Ward:

On December 30, 2009, I performed a complaint investigation near the intersection of W. Mathews and Walnut St. in Jonesboro, AR in accordance with the provisions of the Federal Clean Water Act, the Arkansas Water and Air Pollution Control Act, and the regulations promulgated thereunder. This investigation was in response to a complaint alleging a hydraulic oil spill from a piece of your equipment had not been properly cleaned or reported. The following violations were revealed:

Placing or cause to be placed any sewage, industrial waste, or other wastes in a location where it is likely to cause pollution of any waters of this state in violation of the Arkansas Water and Air Pollution Control Act - A.C.A. §8-4-217 (a)(2).

In October 2009, while performing underground boring for CenterPoint Energy, a piece of equipment operated by your company had a mechanical failure releasing an unknown volume of hydraulic oil to the grass and curb/street in front of 814 Walnut St., Jonesboro, AR. There was no immediate action taken to remediate the spill. Eventually, at the request of officials with CenterPoint Energy, absorbent was deployed, however the spent/contaminated material was never collected for proper disposal and was still visible at the time of my visit. Additionally, contaminated soil was not removed until late December 2009.

Failure to report this incident may have violated the Arkansas Hazardous and Toxic Materials Emergency Notification Act - A.C.A. §12-79.

The above items require your immediate attention. Please submit a written response to these findings to Cindy Garner, Water Division Enforcement Branch Manager, of this Department. This response should be mailed to the address below. This response should contain detailed documentation describing all corrective action taken as of the date of your response and any planned future corrective action. This documentation should contain proof of proper disposal

for all removed materials (absorbents, soil, etc.) Additionally, please provide documentation explaining how any future spills/releases will be managed. This corrective action should be completed as soon as possible, and the written response is due by February 5, 2010.

In response to your phone call from the week of August 30, 2010, regarding the spill complaint in Jonesboro, AR dated December 30, 2009, CenterPoint Energy is pleased to present the following summary.

Robin Dee Enterprises, Inc. (Robin Dee) was installing gas distribution piping on behalf of CenterPoint in Jonesboro AR. A small hydraulic hose leak (less than 1 gallon estimated) occurred during the course of the work. The ADEQ was contacted by others to report an oil spill as well as oil residue on the pavement in the city street. As a result of the complaint and contact by the ADEQ, CenterPoint instructed Robin Dee to contract with US Environmental Services, Inc., (USES) Little Rock AR to abate the spill because they were solely responsible for the operation of their equipment and the hydraulic line.

Excavation of impacted soils was conducted and those soils were profiled and disposed by USES for Robin Dee. In addition, USES sprayed the street and area with MicroBlaze to abate oil stained areas on pavement. A copy of the USES report is attached. Interviews with Robin Dee indicated that the oil stained pavement was likely due to the leaks originating from the operation of a transmission repair shop in the area and were not a result of their construction activities.

Because the release was the sole responsibility of the contractor, they took full responsibility for the spill and paid for the cleanup.


