Dear Mr. Kuncl:

On October 7, 2008, I performed a storm water discharge permit compliance inspection of the above-referenced facility in accordance with the provisions of the Federal Clean Water Act, the Arkansas Water and Air Pollution Control Act, and the regulations promulgated thereunder. The inspection was conducted in response to a complaint. This inspection revealed the following violations:

- 1. Transport of sediment from the construction site causing pollution to the waters of the State. This is in violation of the Arkansas Water and Air Pollution Control Act 8-4-217,(a)(1). Sediment eroded from large unstabilized areas of your site has been transported over the silt fencing at the outfall located at the southeast corner of your site into the natural drainage that flows southward from your site. This drainage is a tributary to the pond on the north end of the complainant's property. This pond has been impacted from the sediment. I received a telephone call from your site inspector following our inspection. He contended that the sediment in the drainage and pond originated from a resident's driveway located on the east side of N. Double Springs Rd. Although gravel from the resident's driveway was observed in the road, it was evident from the site conditions observed during the inspection that sediment present in the drainage and pond originated from your construction site.
- 2. Sediment and erosion controls were not being maintained and were inadequate in critical areas. This is a violation of Part I.C.3 of the permit. The silt fencing used at the outfall described in #1 above was ineffective in eliminating or minimizing pollutants in the storm water discharges from your site and was largely inappropriate for use in that area. The silt fencing created a dam across the drainage. As a result, pollutants in the storm water were caused to discharge untreated over the dam and into the drainage course and pond south of your site. Your storm water pollution prevention plan (SWPPP) map indicates that rip-rap coupled with filter fabric were to be used at this outfall location. These controls would have allowed for treatment of the storm water prior to discharge from your site. In addition, silt fencing in the drainage before the outfall was nearly buried in sediment. It is strongly recommended that while grading activities continue temporary stabilization measures be employed as necessary to prevent further erosion of the slopes at your site.

- 3. The SWPPP was not being kept current. This is in violation of Part II.A.3 of the permit. The SWPPP map identifies and locates many sediment and erosion controls that have not been implemented at your site including 18 check dams and two rip-rap pads with filter fabric. The plan must be amended whenever there is a change in design, construction, operation, or maintenance which has a significant effect on the potential for the discharge of pollutants to the waters of the State. Compliance with this requirement can be accomplished by indicating on the SWPPP map where, in what manner, and on what date modifications of the plan occurred. Each amendment should be initialed by the responsible official.
- 4. Inspections of the construction site were not being performed as required by the SWPPP and the permit. This is in violation of Part II.A.4.e of the permit. An inspection had been conducted by your site inspector on October 7, 2008 prior to our arrival on the site. The inspection report indicated that there were no problems with the condition or effectiveness of the sediment and erosion controls. Conditions observed in the drainage at the site and down stream from the site indicated otherwise.
- 5. No record of the dates indicating when major grading activities occurred, when construction activities temporarily or permanently ceased on a portion of the site, and when stabilization measures were initiated was available for review. This is in violation of Part II.A.4.b.i of the permit.

The above items require your immediate attention. Please submit a written response to these findings to the Water Division Enforcement Branch of this Department at the following address:

This response should contain detailed documentation describing the course of action taken to correct the items noted. This corrective action should be completed as soon as possible, and the written response is due by October 29, 2008.



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
