On April 16, 2007, John Fazio, District Field Inspector, and I conducted a site investigation. At that time, we did not observe a storm water pollution prevention plan; construction site posting in a prominent place for public viewing; sedimentation controls were not being maintained and/or installed properly; stabilization measures needed to be implemented; inspections were not being retained on-site.

On April 27, 2007, I emailed Dave Jurgens, City of Fayetteville Water and Wastewater Director, in order to figure out the name of this project, responsible official, etc. I received an out of office reply stating that he would be out of the office from April 12-May 2. Dave forwarded my email to Shannon Jones. Mr. Jones replied that the engineer of record is H2 Engineering. So, I responded back asking if this is a city project or a development. Mr. Jones replied back with the following: It is a development comprised of multiple developments. The specific project at the White River is called Southeast Fayetteville Water and Sewer Improvements.

Due to lack of information, I contacted Mr. Jones on April 30, 2007.

On May 2, 2007, I contacted H2 Engineering. I spoke with Kipp Hearne, P.E., Vice-President. Mr. Hearne stated that this project began around July 2006. He stated that Edwards Construction was the General Contractor at that time. They had submitted the paperwork to ADEQ for review. However, the contractor refused to sign the SWPPP. Edwards Construction has pulled off the job. According to Mr. Hearne, there is about 3 miles of pipe being laid for sewer and water. Mr. Hearne states that the City of Fayetteville owns the west side of the project and there are multiple developers on the east side of the project. Mr. Hearne wants me to send the letter to the engineering firm and attn: Southeast Fayetteville Water and Sewer Improvements Owners.

I spoke with Jennifer Harmon, Storm Water Engineer, regarding this site on May 2, 2007. She states that they do not have a storm water permit. According to Ms. Harmon, a group of 4-5 developers were trying to be the responsible official. Attached is a letter that was sent in December 22, 2006, to Mike Lamberth and cc: John Nock and Bill Meadows.

On May 3, 2007, Shannon Jones contacted me. He stated that he would contact H2 Engineering to receive the name of the developers. Later that afternoon, I received an email with the following developers company name: Falling Waters, LLC; Meadows Enterprises, Inc; Nock-Broyles Land Development, LLC; and McDonald Real Property Holdings III, LLC.
