Dear Mr. McClung:

On February 11, 2013 I performed a routine compliance inspection of the waste treatment and disposal facility in accordance with the provisions of the Arkansas Water and Air Pollution Control Act and the regulations promulgated thereunder. This inspection revealed the following violations:

- 1. There were numerous spills on the ground around the waste storage system.

  This is in violation of Part I Specific Conditions, Condition 2 of your permit.
- 2. In this permit under Part I Specific Conditions, Condition 12; it states "There are four (4) other storage tanks on site that are closed top and not subject to this permit. The tanks are labeled as Tanks 2,4,5, &6. They are used to store used motor oil, biodiesel, fresh well water and an empty tank." Also, in conversation with Mr. McClung, it was stated that they do have a refueling station on-site. **These activities may require additional permitting.**

Please submit a written response to these findings as well as a full description of your process in detail (day to day operation) to the Water Division Inspection Branch of this Department. This response should be mailed to the address at the bottom of the first page of the letter or emailed to <a href="Water-Inspection-report@adeq.state.ar.us">Water-Inspection-report@adeq.state.ar.us</a> This response should contain documentation describing the course of action taken to correct each item noted. The detailed description of your day to day operations will be forwarded to the Water Division Permits Branch for their review. This corrective action should be completed as soon as possible, and the written response with all necessary documentation (i.e. photos) is due by **February 28, 2013**.


