A staff review has been made of the information received on the referenced project. While the proposed land application sites are not within source water protection areas for any public water sources we have concerns that water-borne pathogens—including E. coli and Cryptosporidium—from the proposed land application sites may pose a risk for body contact on the Buffalo National River, a popular recreational destination.
