

By letter dated December 17, 1974, Mr. J. G. Denton, Jr., Executive-Secretary of the Cache River-Bayou DeView Improvement District requested Mr. Davies to determine the Commission's position with respect to disposal of land clearing debris associated with the channelization project. Copies of Mr. Denton's letter were transmitted to the Commissioners shortly thereafter.

From the information contained in Mr. Denton's letter, the Commission finds that alternative solutions have been considered by the applicant, that greater preservation of the woodlands can be achieved through burning of the debris, and that open burning of the debris offers the optimum long-term solution to the problem of disposal.

In view of the foregoing, the Commission authorizes the staff to proceed with the review and issuance of a permit for open burning, which permit shall assure (1) that the burning along all stretches
