

Permit No. 319-A was issued, with qualifications, to Michigan Chemical Corporation on January 30, 1976. One of the qualifications entailed the submittal, by May 1, 1976, of an approvable permit application reflecting control of sulfur emissions from the wells and extraction facility. Michigan Chemical has informed the staff that lack of performance assurances from the design engineering firm has created the need to adopt an alternative/modified technology and, thus, the preparation of final plans and specifications, has been delayed beyond May 1, 1976, and possibly beyond May 28, 1976.

Permit No. 319-A is hereby modified by deleting the May 1, 1976, requirement for submission of permit applications for control of sulfur emissions. However, Michigan Chemical is hereby required to submit a progress report (or permit application) by May 25, 1976, concerning the control of sulfur emissions. This modification to Permit No. 319-A should not be construed to mean that the attainment date of May 1, 1977, for an operational sulfur control system, as reflected in Permit No. 319-A, has been modified.
