

A Public Hearing was held on September 1, 1977 at Little Rock concerning the following change in the qualification to take the examination for a Class IV Wastewater Operator's License, which appears in Section 7B. (3) (d) in the Rules and Regulations Manual and which presently reads as follows:

"Class IV - Possession of a Class III License and demonstrated ability for at least two (2) years in responsible charge of a Class III or IV wastewater works."

The amendment reads as follows:

"Class IV - Possession of a Class III Unlimited License, at least five (5) years experience or equivalent in wastewater works, and demonstrated ability for at least two (2) years in responsible charge of a wastewater works while holding a Class III License.

After considering all information relating to the amendment to Regulation #3, the Commission hereby approves of the change.
