Crossett, City of (Sanitary Landfill)

Engineer - \*Doyle Kidd & Associates, West Monroe, Louisiana

Site Location - Seven and six-tenths (7.6) acres in the Southeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of Section 27 and the Northeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section 34, Township 18 South, Range 9 West, in Ashley County; approximately two and one-half (2½) miles southwest of Crossett.

Operation - The site is leased from Georgia-Pacific by the city of Crossett which will operate the same for disposal of solid waste generated in Crossett.

Comment - The city landfill operation will provide an adequate facility by which the city of Crossett can dispose of the solid waste.

Provisions - The permittee shall retain a registered professional engineer to inspect the preparation of the site and report the completion of same to the Department prior to commencement of operation. The operation for putrescible waste will be limited only in area "A" and trenches for deposit of this material will not go below an elevation of ninety-two (92) feet. Under no circumstances will any waste be deposited in areas other than those designated as area "A" or "B" on the engineering plans.

Chicot County (Sanitary Landfill), Eudora

Engineer - Dabney Engineering, Inc., Lake Village

Site Location - Approximately twenty-seven (27) acres in the Northeast Half of the Northeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter, Section 2, Township 19 South, Range 2 West, in Chicot County, located approximately one and one-half (1½) miles south of Eudora.

Operation - The site is owned by the city of Eudora and will be operated by Chicot County for the disposal of solid waste generated within Eudora and the south third of the county.

Comment - The operation of this site will provide sanitary landfill disposal of solid waste for the 6,000 residents of the city and county.

Provisions - The permittee shall retain a registered professional engineer to inspect the preparation of the site and report the completion of same to the Department prior to commencement of operation.

The Commission on Pollution Control and Ecology hereby approves issuance of Solid Waste Disposal Permits to the above noted applicants with the above provisions.
