Lime Co.-Cancellation of Permit-Release of Surety

Mr. Paul Oller, owner of Triple "P" Lime Company, located approximately 4 miles north of Washington, Hempstead County, Arkansas, has requested that Permit No. 99 be cancelled and surety of \$1,000.00 be released. The precedence for placing the mining of lime as a quarry operation was established in late 1971 - early 1972 by exemption from Act 236, for one lime production mine (Midwest Lime Company) located near Batesville, Arkansas, and two lime for cement operations mining near Foreman, and White Cliff, Arkansas.

The above reasons for cancellation and precedence was considered at the time of issuance of permit, and then ignored due to Mr. Oller's insistence to permit the two acres.

On the basis of the above, the Mined Land Review Committee and the Department of Pollution Control and Ecology recommends that the Commission honor this individual request.

Based upon the above and the attached recommendations, the Commission hereby approves this permittee's request.
