This permit is your authority to construct, operate, and maintain the waste disposal system set forth in your application dated October 10, 1978. This permit is issued subject to the provisions of Act 472 of 1949, as amended (sec.82-1901 et seq., Ark. Stats.) and the following terms and conditions:

1. The disposal system shall be constructed in accordance with the final plans and specifications as approved by the Department of Pollution Control & Ecology.
2. This permit shall automatically terminate unless construction of the disposal system has been commenced within 6 months of the date hereof and completed with all reasonable diligence. The Department shall be notified in writing when the disposal system has been completed in order that it may be inspected.
3. The disposal system shall be operated by qualified personnel and maintained in good operating condition at all times.
4. By-passing of the disposal system is prohibited and will result in revocation of this permit and/or other appropriate enforcement action by the Department.
5. There shall be no increase in the volume or strength of the waste being treated by the disposal system except within design limits covered by the plans and specifications approved by the Department. No extension or modification of the disposal system may be made without the issuance of a new permit.
6. This permit may be revoked or modified whenever it is necessary, in the opinion of the Department, to prevent or abate pollution of any waters of the State.
7. Nothing herein contained shall be construed as releasing the permittee from any liability for damage to persons or property by reason of the installation, maintenance, or operation of the disposal system.
8. This permit is issued in reliance upon the statements and representations made in the application and the plans and specifications and the Department has no responsibility for the adequacy or proper functioning of the disposal system.

9. Waste shall be applied in such a manner that no discharge to a waterway will occur and all reasonable and necessary measures shall be taken to minimize obnoxious and offensive odors.
10. All operational procedures and/or conditions as outlined in the Soil Conservation Service Design Report for the applicant's facility shall be followed.
11. Appropriate back up waste handling equipment shall be available in the case of equipment malfunction.
12. The inlet channel to the holding pond shall be concrete lined.
13. The applicant shall be responsible for developing and implementing a monitoring program to determine the contributions of the following contaminants from the permitted operations to the White River: Total coliform, fecal coliform, total phosphorous, ammonia-nitrogen, nitrate-nitrogen and BOD. A description of the monitoring program shall be forwarded to, and approved by, the Department of Pollution Control & Ecology no later than 45 days following commencement of operation.
14. The holding pond shall have a uniform clay bottom at least 6 inches in thickness. The clay shall have a coefficient of permeability (k value) no greater than  $10^{-6}$  centimeters per second.
