

MINUTE ORDER NO. 79-22

Garland Coal Company of Fort Smith, Arkansas has requested a release of surety bond for 44 acres reclaimed land covered by Permit number 101 located at the Charleston Mine #1.

On February 21, 1979 the Mined Land Review Committee and the staff of the Department of Pollution Control and Ecology inspected this permit area and was in unanimous agreement that this operator had complied with the reclamation provisions of Act 236 of 1977.

In review of Garland Coal Company's efforts and results, we recommend that this operator's request for release of surety bond in the amount of \$22,000 be granted. This acreage is located in the SE/4 of Section 34, Township 8 North, Range 28 West, Franklin County, Arkansas.

Based upon the above and attached information, the Commission hereby approves the operator's request.




The Mined Land Review Committee and the Department were in full agreement that this operator has satisfied the requirements of Act 236 of 1971.
