SUBJECT: Request for reduction of surety for Permit #91 consisting of 10 acres as fully reclaimed.

Sugarloaf Mining of Fort Smith has requested reduction of surety for permitted properties as fully reclaimed.

On May 8, 1979 a Field Trip for Acceptance was conducted by members of the Mined Land Review Committee and the Department of Pollution Control and Ecology.

The area inspected was permitted in October, 1975. This was Permit #91 consisting of 10 acres, and the area reclaimed was leveled approximately to original contour, reseeded with multiple grass that have produced excellent revegetative cover. This cover is now 2 to 3 years of age and the total area for reclamation is approximately 20 acres. The overage is due to reclaiming prelaw spoil to provide pleasing view along Highway 71. This acreage is located as part of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 24, Township 5 North, Range 31 West, Sebastian County, Arkansas.


The Mined Land Review Committee and the Department were in unanimous agreement that this operator has fully satisfied the requirements of Act 236 of 1971.
