- 13. Summary Comments The low permeability of the soils is advantageous  
toward preventing underground water pollution. However, operation  
during wet weather could be difficult unless proper on-site roads are  
constructed in advance. Permit limited to the 11 acres that are covered  
in the engineering plans.
