


At the regular commission meeting on May 25, 1979, the Commission re-established the building ban on the Highway 270 West Sewer Improvement District in Hot Springs until such time that construction had begun on the project. This was due to a resolution being sent to the Commission that stated that the people did not desire new taxes being imposed at that time and the district did not intend to proceed with further planning and construction of the proposed project.


After the order was re-established a poll was taken of the affected area and a majority of the residents expressed a desire for the project.

As a result of that poll another resolution of intent (attached) was passed by the district commissioners stating that the district did intend to proceed with construction, operation and maintenance of the proposed facilities. This resolution was dated July 19, 1979 and was sent to the Commission.

Based on these assurances and consistent with the staff's recommendation the Commission hereby lifts the building ban previously imposed on the Highway 270 West Sewer Improvement District.

RESOLUTION OF INTENT

Resolution indicating that the Highway 270 West Sewer Improvement District having the necessary legal, financial, institutional and managerial resources intends to construct, operate, and maintain certain proposed sewage facilities, if such works are approved and funded by the state and federal governments.

WHEREAS, the Highway 270 West Sewer Improvement District possesses the necessary legal, financial, institutional and managerial resources to construct, operate and maintain sewage collection and pumping facilities, and;


WHEREAS, the existing individual sewage facilities have been determined to be in violation of current state and federal requirements, and;

WHEREAS, the recently completed facility planning report, prepared in accordance with the final construction grant regulations, 40 CFR, Part 35, Sub-Part E, dated February 11, 1974, recommends certain sewage improvements within the district which will satisfy state and federal requirements.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Highway 270 West Sewer Improvement District hereby indicates its concurrence with the proposed recommended facilities in the referenced planning report and that the district intends to construct, operate and maintain such proposed facilities in accordance with state and federal regulations, if said facilities are approved and funded by the state and U.S. Environmental Protection Agency.
