

The Commission hereby approves the formation of a technical advisory committee to be known as the Arkansas Hazardous Waste Technical Advisory Committee in accordance with the provision of the Arkansas Hazardous Waste Management Act of 1979.

Within sixty days after the date of this order the Committee shall report to the Commission on the following:

- (1) adequacy of financial responsibility requirements under 40 CFR 250 and the means of establishing adequate post-closure financial responsibilities for hazardous waste management facilities;
- (2) certification requirements for operators and personnel of commercial and non-commercial hazardous waste management facilities;
- (3) availability and need for training programs for operators and personnel of hazardous waste management facilities;
- (4) means by which the volume and the hazardous properties of hazardous waste can be reduced through recovery, re-use, treatment, or destruction;
- (5) the development of a schedule of fees as provided in Section 5(i) of the Arkansas Hazardous Waste Management Act of 1979;
- (6) the adequacy of the procedures set forth in 40 CFR 250 for the identification of hazardous waste;
- (7) the desirability and feasibility of establishing a permit system which would establish different standards and permit requirements for hazardous waste management facilities according to the degree of hazard presented by the individual facility, taking into account the nature of the waste and the means by which such waste is stored, treated or disposed;
- (8) criteria for siting hazardous waste management facilities;
- (9) the design of permit application forms; and
- (10) such other considerations as the Committee may find necessary to formulate the establishment of an effective hazardous waste management program within Arkansas.

Formation and Procedures of the Committee

- (a) The Arkansas Hazardous Waste Technical Advisory Committee shall be comprised of not less than ten (10) members and not more than twenty (20) members. The members of the Committee shall be nominated by the Director, approved by the Commission and serve with the concurrence of the Governor. Members shall be nominated upon the basis of their education, training and experience in the fields of biology, geology, chemistry, engineering, education, public health, industrial hygiene, transportation, industry, finance, agriculture, hazardous waste management, solid waste management or other related matters.
- (b) Members of the Committee shall serve without compensation but may be reimbursed for travel expenses for meetings authorized by the Director.
- (c) The duties of the Committee shall be to assist and advise the Department in the development of procedures, standards, criteria, rules and regulations.
- (d) The Committee may establish its own rules for the orderly conduct of its business, provided that such rules do not conflict with the laws and regulations of Arkansas.
- (e) The Director and the Committee shall be furnished copies of the minutes of all meetings of the Committee.
- (f) All meetings of the Committee shall be open to the public.
