COMMISSION POLICY REGARDING RECEIPT OF PUBLIC COMMENTS

At all times in which the Department publishes notice advising the public of opportunity for comment upon applications for permits or programs and other matters within the jurisdiction of the Department, the notice shall clearly state the date to and including which comments shall be received by the public, and that comments submitted after that date (will not) (may not)* be considered by the Department staff or the Commission. The closing date for public comment shall not apply to comments or recommendations on any issue by the Department staff to the Commission.

On any matter or issue on which public comment has been received pursuant to published public notice, the Commission (may) permit additional comment from the public or any interested party or their representatives at any meeting of the Commission at which such issue is considered, subject to such limitations on time and number of speakers on each side of such issue or matter as the Commission shall determine prior to receiving such additional comment. If the Commission determines that additional comment would not serve a useful purpose, would be repetitious or unduly time-consuming, it may determine to not receive any additional comments.

*(use of "will not" would make it mandatory that comments received after the closing date not be considered. Use of "may not" would make consideration of late comments discretionary, based upon total number and length of comments, the date on which the late comments were received, and other factors)
