SUBJECT: Request by Crown Construction for partial reduction of surety on permit #17-79-76A-3, based on permittee's final bladed and graded surface and topsoil placement.

A field trip was conducted on February 13, 1981 by the Department and the Mined Land Review Committee members on the permit area for the purpose of evaluating the grading, blading and topsoil placement. The requirements for the new surface contour have been met, and adequate seeding and mulching is in place and waiting for the required growth.

It was determined and agreed upon by the Department and the Mined Land Review Committee members, that the operator's efforts should be approved for a 75% reduction of surety on this permit.
