

MINUTE ORDER NO. 81-37

COMMUNITY PRIORITY SYSTEM & LIST

The staff has reviewed the transcript of the public hearing on the FY81 Construction Grants Small Community priority system and list held March 18, 1981.

Based on that review, the staff is recommending the following changes to the system and list:

(1) The wording in the emergency clause under part III of the system should be amended to state that an emergency situation will move a municipality from a lower category to category two, not category one as was originally written.

(2) The following paragraph will be added to the system. It will read as follows:

"The State may utilize bypass procedures to select the project or projects which lie outside the fundable range on the list if such a selection is necessary to prevent the loss of mandatory setasides for innovative and alternative technology or small community alternative systems."

(3) The following will be added to the priority system. It will read as follows:

"The State may reduce a Step 2+3 project shown on the fundable portion of the priority list down to only the Step 2 portion if assurances of local financing for Step 3 are not available within the timeframe established by the United States Environmental Protection Agency's PRM 80-3."

(4) The town of Lynn will be added to the fundable portion of the priority list for its Step 2 award.

(5) Due to the reduction of Federal funds for FY81, Mountain View and Pojeon will be funded for Step 2 grants rather than the Step 2+3's originally shown on the list.

By this minute order the Commission on Pollution Control and Ecology approves the FY81 Small Community Priority System and List as presented at the public hearing but with the incorporation of the staff recommendations made above.
