

A public hearing was held July 17, 1981 at which time no public comments were received on proposed revisions to the Water Quality Management Plan (208 Plan) which are:

- (1) Changes in population projections to incorporate 1980 census figures;
- (2) changes in the discharge points of municipal wastewater treatment plants at Searcy, Ashdown, Clarksville, Murfreesboro, and Morrilton;
- (3) incorporation into the plan of wasteload allocation studies performed in connection with wastewater treatment plant construction activities proposed for DeQueen, Hardy, Pangburn, Norman, Conway, Glenwood, Gravette, Subiaco, and Wilmar; and
- (4) additions or changes to the list of municipalities and sewer improvement districts designated as management agencies for carrying out provisions of the 208 Plan in their respective areas of the state.

Subsequently, two letters were received commenting on the revisions to the population projections. Based on these comments no changes were made to the original documents.

The Commission hereby approved these revisions to the Water Quality Management Plan.
