SUBJECT: Request by Triark, Incorporated for reduction of surety on permit #95, consisting of 30 acres, as having been fully reclaimed.

A field trip for inspection, was conducted on November 2, 1981 by the Mined Land Review Committee. Permit #95 was issued under Act 236 of 1971 and a complete inspection of the permit area revealed that the back-filling and blading for the new surface was acceptable. There are no water impoundments on the permit area. The vegetative cover, consisting of native grasses, was providing good stabilization for the new surface and was deemed acceptable.

On behalf of the operator's efforts, it is recommended that the request for reduction of surety, in the amount of \$15,000, be honored.


