

On September 25, 1981, the Commission adopted Minute Order 81-90 entitled "Resolution: Beaver Lake". Among the provisions of the resolution was the charge to the department to conduct a public meeting in northwest Arkansas for the explicit purpose of receiving comments from interested parties concerning the uses and impacts of water quality management practices in the Beaver Lake Watershed. Additionally, the Commission would thereafter form a Citizens Advisory Committee made up of not more than eleven (11) qualified citizens from the area for the sole purpose of providing comments and suggestions to the Commission on water quality management in the Beaver Lake Watershed.

On December 1, 1981, a public meeting was held in Rogers, Arkansas, to receive comments from the public. Two hundred and twenty one (221) citizens were in attendance at the meeting to express their concern for the Beaver Lake Watershed area and to voice their approval for the Commissions' initiatives.

As a result of this public meeting and subsequent letters and considerations the Department of Pollution Control and Ecology presents to the Commission the following items for its consideration and approval:

- 1) That the original Citizens Advisory Committee membership number of eleven (11) be expanded to thirteen (13) to more adequately represent the level of interest in the northwest Arkansas area.
- 2) That in addition to the Citizens Advisory Committee already authorized by Minute Order 81-90, an Ex-Officio, non-voting group of advisors be established to assist the Citizens Advisory Committee in their tasks. The Ex-Officio membership would consist of one representative from each of the following groups:
