

SUBJECT: Request by Mr. Bill Glass, principal and property owner, for reduction of surety for General Fuels Corporation permit #252-M-CO, consisting of 12.54 acres.


A field trip was conducted by the Mined Land Review Committee on January 5, 1982 to determine the status of reclamation on permit #252.


On completion of inspection and discussion, it was determined that the new surface and pine tree vegetation cover was acceptable. This permit was affected for approximately 3.5 acres and is now reclaimed.

Based on the above observations, the Mined Land Review Committee recommends that the request be honored for an 85% reduction from a total of \$8,250, amounting to \$7,012.50.
