

SUBJECT: Request for release of surety bond by Acme Brick Company


Acme Brick Company of Malvern has requested the release of surety bond on 82 of 92 acres covered by Permit Number 195.

This International Shale mine is on Hartsell Road, Section 23 T4S R18W, Hot Spring County.


