

WHEREAS, Governor's Proclamation EM 83-2 was issued to provide funds for the removal of soils and oils, highly contaminated with PCB's, in a Fort Smith residential area; and

WHEREAS, ENSCO, Inc. and its subsidiary, America Industrial Waste Management, Inc., provided means of promptly and effectively transporting the contaminated materials to ENSCO's facility for the thermal oxidation of the PCB's; and

WHEREAS, ENSCO, Inc. volunteered said services at costs as a matter of public service and in the interest of removing a significant source of environmental contamination; and

WHEREAS, ENSCO's actions have resulted in the safe, professional removal, transportation, and treatment of some 240 cubic yards of material without incident; and

NOW BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, that the Commission on Pollution Control and Ecology hereby expresses its appreciation to the stockholders, management, and employees of ENSCO, Inc., for their display of citizenship and responsibility to Arkansas.
