PUBLIC NOTICE

The Arkansas Commission on Pollution Control and Ecology, in accordance with the provisions of the Arkansas Water and Air Pollution Control Act of 1949, as amended, issues the following notice of receipt of application for a sanitary landfill permit.

The City of Bentonville has submitted an application to the Department of Pollution Control and Ecology to construct and operate a sanitary landfill on 10.5 acres of land the city owns. The property is located 3/4 mile east of U. S. Highway 71 and 1/2 mile north of Bentonville near the city's sewage treatment plant. The property is further described as follows: Southeast 1/4, Northeast 1/4, Section 19, Township 20, Range 30 West, all in Benton County, Arkansas.

Bentonville officials plan to dispose of approximately 15 tons of residential and commercial wastes and 10 tons of industrial wastes per day at the landfill. Waste will be collected from residences, businesses and industry within Bentonville. No hazardous or infectious wastes would be permitted into the landfill under the terms of the application.

Any interested person may submit written requests for a public hearing on this application to the following addressee: Jim Bearden, Solid Waste Hearing Officer, Department of Pollution Control and Ecology, P. O. Box 9583, 8001 National Drive, Little Rock, Arkansas 72219. If five (5) such requests are received by the Hearing Officer, or at the Department, by 5:00 p.m., September 13, 1982, a public hearing will be scheduled and notice will be given in accordance with state law.
