It is hereby recommended that the operator's request for total surety reduction of \$5,000.00 be granted.









Sugarloaf Mining Company has requested the reduction of remaining surety for permit #98 issued for 20 acres.

SUBJECT: Sugarloaf Mining Company of Fort Smith, Arkansas has requested the reduction of remaining surety for permit #98 issued for 20 acres in January 1976. Due to having mined and reclaimed only 13 acres, it then followed on acceptance that 13 acres of surety was released. The intent at this time is for reduction of the surety on the remaining 7 acres not mined or affected in the permit.

A field trip for inspection and conformation of the remaining 7 acres as not having been mined or affected, was made on this date by the Mined Land Review Committee Members. Following this inspection it was agreed by the committee that this operators request is correct.


On the basis of this inspection it is recommended that this operator's request be granted. The total remaining surety for this permit is \$3,500.00 for total release of permit #98.




